NAPA/SOLANO AREA AGENCY ON AGING MEETING PROTOCOL IN RESPONSE TO CORONAVIRUS COVID 19

California Governor Gavin Newsom issued Executive Order N-25-20 on March 12, 2020, relating to the convening of public meetings in light of the COVID-19 pandemic. The Napa/Solano Area Agency on Aging hereby provides notice that it will continue to convene its regularly scheduled public meetings of the Oversight Board and the Advisory Council telephonically, as provided in the publicly posted agenda notice, and until further notice. Pursuant to the Executive Order, and to maintain the orderly conduct of the meeting, the Napa/Solano Area Agency on Aging will allow Board members and Council members to attend the meetings telephonically and to participate in the meetings to the same extent as if they were present.

Members of the public who wish to participate may participate telephonically. For members of the public who wish to participate but not to attend telephonically, you may submit written comments on any matter within the Board or Council's subject matter jurisdiction, regardless of whether it is on the agenda for Board or Council consideration or action, and those comments will be entered into the administrative record of the meeting. To submit written comments by U.S. Mail or email for inclusion in the meeting record, they must be received by the Napa/ Solano Area Agency on Aging staff no later than 9:00 a.m. on the morning prior to the noticed meeting. Staff Report September 2021

1. Provider Updates

Senior Resource Fair is being held at the KROC Center in Suisun. Many of our Solano County providers will attend. Meals on Wheels Information and Assistance will be handing out Senior Resource Guides and be available to answer questions.

Share the Care Napa Valley moved and held an open house at their new facility. Dane, Donna, and Susan all attended the event.

2. Master Plan Playbook

Reviewing scope of work. Will separate the plan into two county-wide programs. Working with Kris Brown in Napa County and Gwendolyn Gill in Solano County on next steps for each county.

3. Hubs and Spokes/ADRC

Lots of work is being done by CDA to promote the "Hubs and Spokes" model of care and ADRC (Aging and Disability Resource Center) model moving forward. AAAs and ILC (Independent Living Centers) are the foundation of the model. CDA is holding a series of meetings discussing the model and asking for input. Public comment will end soon.

4. Reopening

Due to the resurgence of COVID, many senior centers are remaining closed. Our providers continue to offer hybrid services.

5. CDA Funding

The state will release additional funding on the following calendar

- a. Consolidated Appropriations Act and Elder Justice Funding September
- b. American Rescue Plan Funding October
- c. Area Plan Amendment 1 including additional funding for senior nutrition, baseline increase, and LTSS -- September
