

The Oversight Board shall consist of seven (7) members as follows:

- One (1) member from each County Board of Supervisors, or its designees, and an alternate to attend and vote at meetings of the member in his or her absence.
- One (1) member from a City Council in each County, appointed by the respective city selection committee established pursuant to Section 50270 of the Government Code, and an alternate to attend and vote at meetings of the member in his or her absence.
- One (1) member of the senior (60+) community in each County, appointed iii. by the respective Board of Supervisors, and an alternate to attend and vote at meetings of the member in his or her absence.
- One (1) member at large from each County, appointed by the respective Board of Supervisors, and an alternate to attend and vote at meetings of the member in his or her absence, with one member a voting member and the other member a non-voting member, who shall rotate annually. The first voting member to be determined by the Oversight Board by lot, effective January 1.

SECTION 2. TERM OF OFFICE

The initial term of the members in Section (iii) and (iv) shall be six years from the effective date of appointment. The term of the remaining members in Section 1 shall be four years from the effective date of appointment. Upon the expiration of each member's term, the term of each succeeding member shall be four years. Any member of the Oversight Board may be removed at any time by their appointing authority, if required by these Bylaws, or if the member ceases to be a Supervisor or City Council member.
